3. Weight requirement: 230-280 lbs.
4. Open to purebred and crossbred barrows and gilts.
5. Gilts shown in breeding classes cannot be shown in market classes.
6. Nipple waterer required.
7. Due to weight variances and weight limits, the fair will set the number of weight classes.
8. All livestock exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding.

4-H AND FFA CARCASS SWINE**

**ENTRY FEE - \$3.50 per animal
Limited to one entry per exhibitor**

1. Open to purebred and crossbred barrows and gilts that must also be entered as a market animal. That meets the weight requirements of the market classes. Weight requirement on swine is 230-280 pounds.
2. **Animals must be entered in both the Market Class as well as the Carcass Contest.** One of the two Market animals may be designated to compete in an Ultrasound carcass contest. The animal must be designated at time of weigh in.
3. Animals entered in the Ultrasound classes must be entered and shown in the Market Classes.
4. Hogs must meet the minimum back fat standards of the contest or they will be disqualified.
5. Results to be announced at the close of the Market Show Champion Drive. Carcass results will have no effect on placing in the Market show.
