

ENTRIES 101

- Read the *General Rules*
- Take note and follow all rules and guidelines pertaining to the department entering - this information is located at the beginning of each department
- Pay special attention to highlighted rules
- There may not be a class for an item you wish to enter
- **Entry Forms**
 - Be sure to use the correct Entry Form
 - Entry fees may be combined in one check
 - Example: The Smith Family
Jane Smith \$2
John Smith \$3
Sally Smith \$2

Check Total \$7
 - Entry forms and fees **must** have a postmark date of **August 1st** or earlier.
 - **Print Legibly**
- **Livestock Entries**
 - Be sure of arrival and release times
 - Read the health requirements

- Be sure to complete the "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form and send it with your entry form
 - If entering an animal in Open Class and 4-H - entry fees must be paid for both 4-H and Open
- **Inside Home Economic, 4-H, and Agricultural Entries**
 - Exhibits are to arrive:
Thursday, August 18th - 4pm-8pm
 - Exhibits are released:
Sunday, August 28th - 9:30am - 12:30pm
 - It is highly recommended that a self-addressed stamped envelope be sent in with entry forms in order to receive entry tags prior to August 18th - this way corrections can be made if necessary and the entry process will go smoothly on August 18th
 - Be sure to consider the number of tags being returned when affixing postage to the SASE.
 - You may make only one entry per class.

A Guide to Making Inside Exhibit Entries

On Thursday, August 18th, 4 pm -8pm. Be sure to arrive in plenty of time to get to the various buildings to deliver your entries. If you are picking up and attaching your entry tags on Thursday, more time will be needed. The buildings will be closed promptly at 8 pm in order to prepare for judging on Friday. The following is a general guideline as to where to take your entries when you arrive at the fairgrounds. Please refer to the map of the fairgrounds.

4-H Door A: Benefit Auction Items, Photography, Foods and Nutrition, Baked Goods, Nutrition Posters, Club Exhibits and Club Scrapbooks.

4-H Door B: Vegetables

4-H Door C: Bicycling, Conservation, Electricity, Entomology, Fishing, Flowers, Forestry, Geology, Leisure Ed, Rockets, Wildlife and Woodworking.

4-H Door D: Arts & Crafts, Clothing, Cloverbuds, Family Relations, Jewelry, Scrapbooking and Theatre Arts.

Family Living Door A: Clothing, Foods and Art.

Family Living Door B: Photography

Family Living Door C: Quilts, Afghans, Yarnwork, Needlework and Handicrafts.

Agricultural Door A: Fruits & Nuts, Flowers, and Apiary.

Agricultural Door B: Vegetables, Hay, Grain and Scarecrows.
